



Tuition and Financial Aid Information

Monthly Tuition Rates 2022 - 2023

To create a school where children of different socioeconomic backgrounds come together for excellent early education, Arch Street Preschool accepts government subsidies, offers financial scholarships, and asks families to pay full tuition if they are able to. All of our families contribute. Arch Street Preschool is an equal opportunity provider. Families enrolling after 5/1/2021 start at the new rate. Families enrolled in the 2020-2021 school year change to the new rate on 9/1/2021. The Toddler Preschool Program is for children under age 4 and the Pre-K Program is for children over age 4 as of 9/1/2021.

Fees

Arch Street Preschool chooses to include most school fees with the tuition. Additional fees:

- Drop-in (as available): \$120 for full-day, \$60 for half-day.
- Early drop off (as available): \$20 per day (7:30 am; arranged with Director)
- Late pick up: \$1 per minute
- Late payment: \$25 if tuition is not received by the 1st of each month.
- Enrichment programs contribution (soccer, gymnastics, dance, etc.): Pay what you can, approximately \$80 per season

Child Care Works Subsidized Care Program (CCW)

Financial Scholarships

Families interested in applying for a financial scholarship must:

1. Schedule a tour of the program, apply for admission, and indicate their interest in financial aid.

3. Submit a copy of the most recent tax returns, W-2s, 1040 tax forms and supporting schedules, and a letter explaining financial circumstances and the need for a scholarship.
